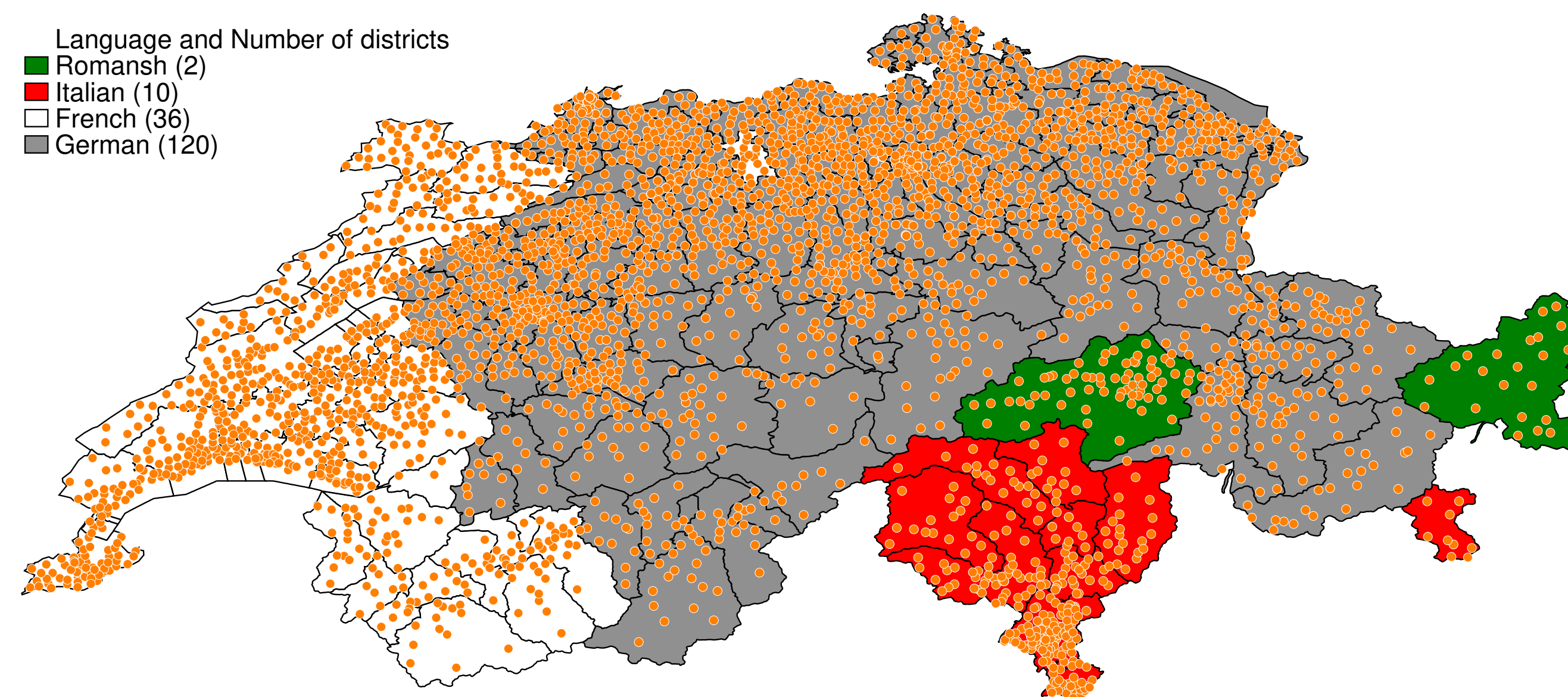

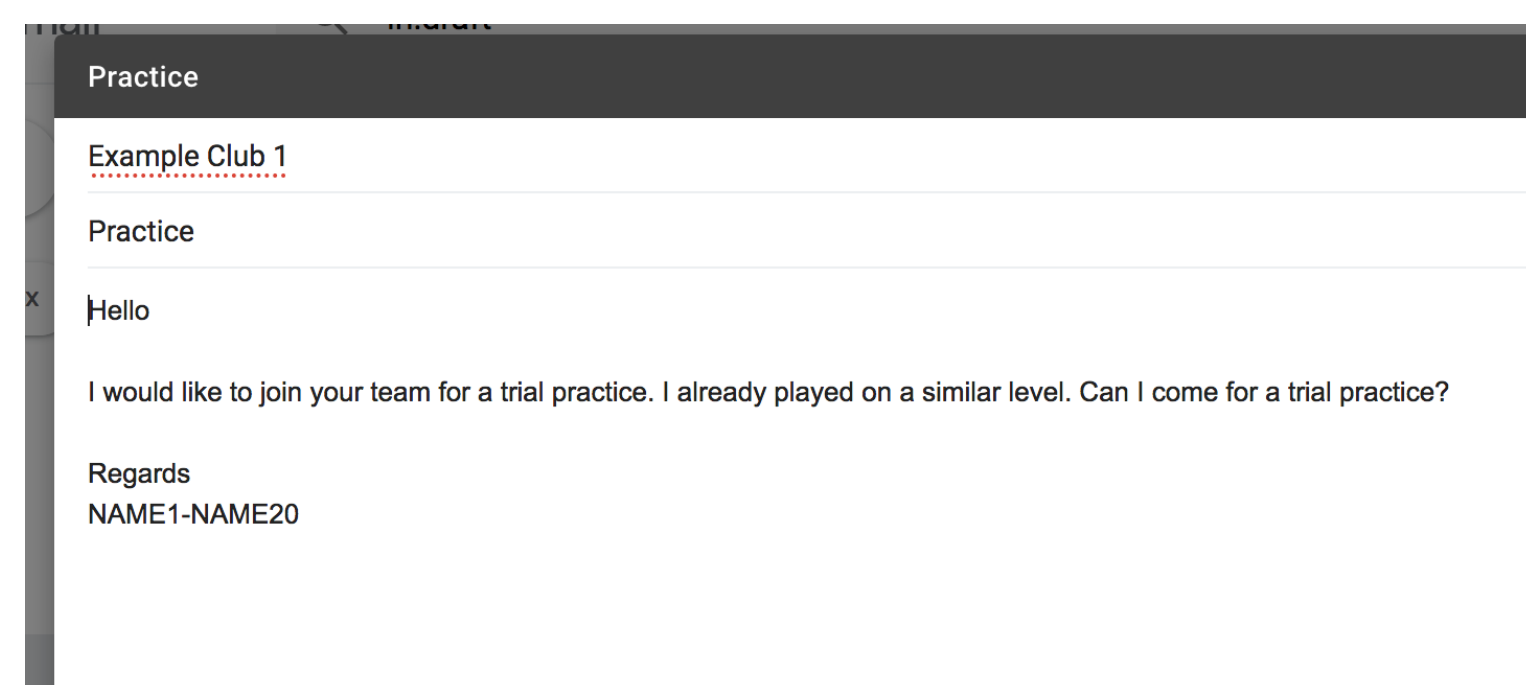
Overview. What did we do?

1. We looked up all football clubs in Switzerland.

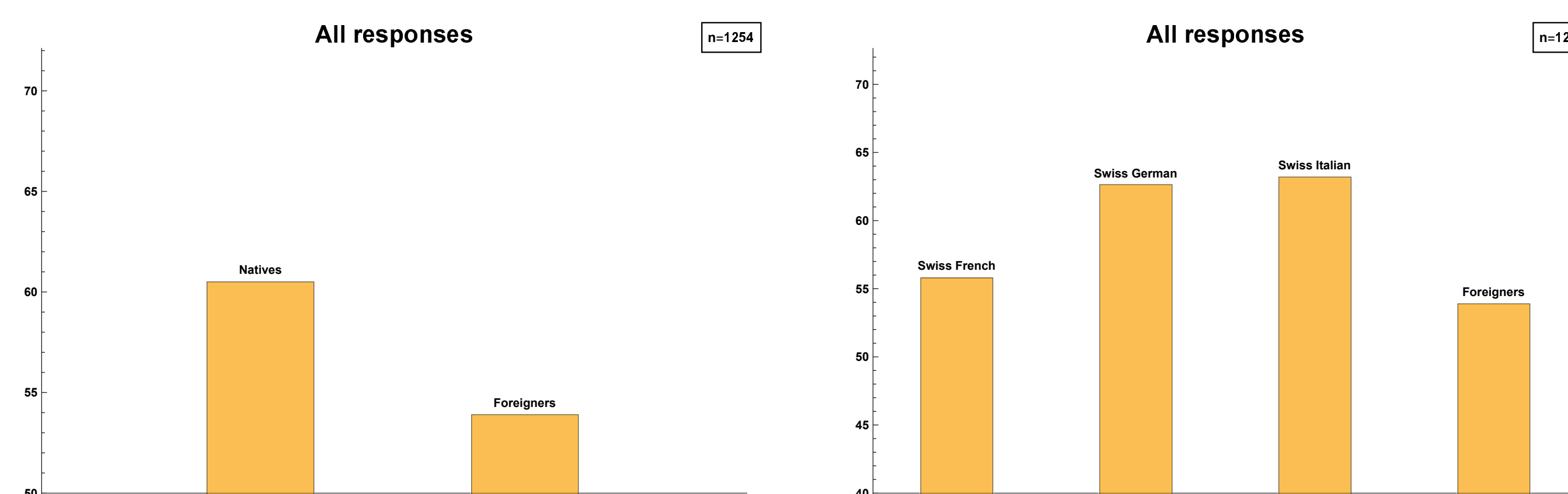


3. Wrote mails ("applications") to the football clubs.
